 Los Angeles Olympics during the Cold War era, the USSR
 withdrew from the competition.
- The USSR flag prominently displayed in The Olympic Pole Vaulter was deemed a historical anomaly. The prints were placed in permanent storage.
- Never released, these prints have been kept and preserved for over 30 years. Until now.
- This collectible, unique lithograph is a wonderful example of Leroy Neiman's iconic style. Its unique historical and commemorative value adds intrigue to its visual appeal.
